

# BASIC JEWELRY TECHNIQUES

## "Shortening"

Use Lauren, but don't clasp it at the end. Clasp it further in.

## Making a "Y" Necklace

Use Party necklace and attach the clasp in front, a couple of inches from the other end, thus leaving a couple of inches dangling down to make a "Y".

## "FLIPPING"

Put on Angelina and Lauren necklaces, then "flip" Angelina cross through Lauren a few times.

## "Doubling"

Double a 30" or longer necklace to create a 15" choker.

## "LAYERING"

Put on Angelina, then put Bellissimo on top of it, so that Angelina is covered up by Bellissimo and the cross hangs below as a pendant.

## "Pendant on a Scarf"

Slide Summit Pendant onto a scarf and wear scarf as a necklace or choker with pendant dangling.

## "EXTENDING"

Attach Spectrum Bracelet to Spectrum Necklace

## "LOOPING"

Using a 30" necklace with its clasp closed, bring two looped ends to the front of neck (while clasp is in the back) and attach the two loops together with a pin, like So Pretty, Spiral or Daybreak.

## "TWISTING"

Hold Final Touch (without the pendant) and Lauren necklaces by their ends. Using a circular motion, twist the two necklaces around each other.

## "Pin as a Pendant"

After twisting Final Touch and Lauren necklaces together, pin Sundial to the front as a "pendant".
