

# How Does Your Total Look Add Up?

An easy way to determine whether you wear too many or too few accessories is to give each piece a value of 1, 2, 3, or 4 points as shown in the chart. Then add or subtract until your outfit totals between 12 and 24 points for a totally pulled-together look!

*\*Wear earrings that flatter you face shape!*

*\*Subtract points for orangey "suntan" hosiery...tiny ear studs...no makeup!*

NOTE: Natural fashion personalities should strive to avoid the "doldrums" by scoring at least 12. Dramatics must be careful not to look to "overdone" - score no more than 24.

<b>NECKLACES</b> One thin hardly noticeable gold chain or one strand of pearls	One heavy chain or interesting beads	Mix of chains with pearls	Conversation-piece necklace
<b>BRACELETS:</b> One thin, delicate gold or silver chain bracelet	One 1/2" wide chain or bangle bracelet	Two or more small bangles or a cuff-style bracelet.	A 1" wide chain bracelet or cuff-style bracelet
<b>RINGS:</b> Small ring (can be wedding ring)	Two small rings	One small ring and one large "check-writing" ring	Two large rings
<b>SCARVES</b> Solid-colored scarf	Muted multi-colored scarf	Bright, multi-colored scarf	Bright, multi-colored oversized scarf
<b>BELTS</b> 1" wide neutral leather belt	1 to 2" wide textured or "skin" belt	2 to 3" wide pastel or brightly colored belt	3" wide or wider belt with unusual buckle, or a chain belt
<b>CLOTHING COLORS/PATTERNS</b> Only Neutral shades of clothing such as black, brown, navy, camel or beige	Subdued prints and/or colors	Bright colors, prints mixed with bright solids	Bright contrasting solid or separates (purple jacket/red skirt), large prints, mixed prints
<b>SHOES</b> Neutral color shoes, flats, 1" or lower heel	Neutral color pumps 1 1/2" to 2" heels	2-3" heels in color that coordinates with outfit.	3" or more heels with 2-tone or more colors
